In the world of business – in good times or in bad – one thing holds true: there is always a need for Chartered Accountants.

This demand continues to attract the best and brightest students to the CA profession in Canada.

“CAs are valued for their integrity, experience and expertise,” says Kevin Dancy, FCA, president and CEO of the Canadian Institute of Chartered Accountants. “It is a great career choice for students, whether they want to become a professional accountant, a corporate executive or a leader in other sectors.”

Compared to other professional degrees, the CA designation offers a unique advantage: “CAs are never going to be afraid of the numbers. When we look at business today, that is very important.”

The values, knowledge and skills of the CA professional are more important in today's economic climate than ever before, says Mr. Dancy.

The Canadian CA profession has mutual recognition agreements with our nation's major trading partners. That means the designation offers international mobility for individuals, while at the same time making it possible for Canadian organizations to hire professionals with experience in international environments.

Through the CA Training Office (CATO) program, students can now develop competencies within the corporate or government sectors. This expansion of the practical experience options beyond public accounting allows individuals to pursue a CA designation while working in their chosen fields.

“It's not just learning from the book – it is going out and doing the work. We then test to ensure that people have developed the competencies a newly admitted CA is required to have. It's the combination – education, evaluation and experience – that is unique. It is a demanding process that is good for the individual, as well as for the clients and companies that they work for,” says Mr. Dancy.

For many of Canada's leading executives, the designation is both a source of opportunity and a foundation for success. “The CA designation was a springboard for my career,” says Lou Ragagnin, CA, chief operating officer of the Canadian Olympic Committee. “That knowledge base is a key to personal growth and to success within business, non-profit and government organizations.”

After working in a leading national public accounting firm, Mr. Ragagnin served as an executive in legal and real estate companies before joining the Canadian Olympic Committee as executive director in 1998. “It was an opportunity for me to make a difference within the Olympic movement by applying strategic skills and business discipline,” he says.

“The grounding you get within a professional services firm provides discipline and professionalism as well as technical skills,” says Mr. Ragagnin. “A CA is valuable within any organization, whether in a finance or management capacity. The perspective we acquire over the years – a strategic approach to thinking and problem-solving across the entire organization – is indispensable.”

The CA designation is highly valuable, agrees Jolene Mahody, CA, chief operating officer of Jazz Air in Nova Scotia. “It's a ticket to a wide variety of career choices. The training you receive and the skill sets you develop greatly enhance the options available to you. It's widely recognized as being rigorous, so there is an immediate recognition of accomplishment.”

After training within a public accounting firm, Ms. Mahody joined the airline industry as an assistant comptroller in the early 1990s and held a variety of finance roles until 2002. That year, she moved away from pure accounting and finance, and has since served in a variety of administrative and operational positions. “I've relied on the analytical skills and financial knowledge I gained during my CA training throughout my entire career,” she says.

Whatever the nature of the role – be it financial, operational, administrative or overall leadership, whether the organization is public or private, large or small – there are key skills that enhance the likelihood of success, she says. “The CA program provides strong analytical skills, financial understanding and the ability to make good decisions and exercise sound judgment. You continue to develop these skills as you grow in your career, of course, but the basics are learned through the CA program.”

Becoming a CA is more than just a career choice, she says, it's an avenue to all kinds of future opportunities. “Many individuals don't know what they want to do when they finish university. The CA designation is a great way to go, because you're making the choice to obtain skills and a designation that will open a lot of doors for you.” □

CAs CAN EARN THEIR STRIPES IN NEW WAYS

Until a few years ago, university graduates seeking to earn the coveted CA designation competed for articling positions in the audit and assurance practices of Canada's public accounting firms. Today, while the majority of CA students continue to train in this traditional channel, a growing number of aspiring CAs now train in approved government and corporate organizations, as well as in other practice areas in CA firms.

This change resulted from the introduction two years ago of CA Training Offices (CATOs) having the ability to offer expanded experience opportunities.

Today, there are over 70 CATOs that have been approved to train CAs in these new paths. They provide CA students with the rigorous training the profession demands through hands-on experience in corporate and public sector work, and in additional practice areas within public accounting firms.

“It's a matter of supply and demand,” says John Gunn, FCA, CEO of the CA School of Business in Western Canada. “Many of our members

spend much of their careers in the corporate world or in government, and CA skills are very much in demand in those sectors. We had a situation where many qualified students were seeking CA careers, and there were not enough training positions to meet that demand. The profession was losing good students who wanted to become CAs.”

The growing list of corporate CATOs include organizations as diverse as Bell Aliant, Research in Motion and Union Gas. Training opportunities now available in government include the Offices of the Comptroller General of Canada, Newfoundland and Labrador, and New Brunswick.

Ronald Williams, CA, Newfoundland and Labrador Comptroller General, says, “The CATO program helps to improve the retention of professionals within the government and provides a learning environment that supports professional growth.”

CA students who train in the Comptroller General's office have an opportunity to learn in a unique environment, he says. “You are exposed to various aspects of government processes, policies and legislation.”

Melissa Lai worked in banking during her co-op terms in university, so RBC's CATO program was a natural choice for her CA training. “I knew I was going to end up working in the financial services industry, so training at RBC just made sense. I've audited in wealth management, retail banking and insurance. Right now, I'm working in head office finance.”

“By the time I finish my three-year training program, I will have a uniquely broad perspective on RBC's various operations.”

THEY DID IT. CAN YOU?

Some students liken it to a three-year-long marathon race. Others say it is like being an intern in a busy hospital emergency ward – long evenings of study preceded by even longer days of work. They all agree, however, that the effort is worth the prize: the right to append the initials “CA” after their names.

Achieving the CA designation involves a rigorous course of post-university study and various levels of testing in the three years it usually takes from start to finish. The most intensive period of work and study leads to the three full days during which all aspiring Canadian Chartered Accountants take their Uniform Evaluation, known as the “UFE,” an acronym that still

reflects its original name – the Uniform Final Examination. By any name, it's one of the most demanding professional exams in the world.

The UFE is designed to test higher-order learning skills and competencies as well as knowledge, professional judgment and ethics, says Irene Wiecek, FCA, senior lecturer of accounting at the University of Toronto. “It's a simulation of real-life, professional decision-making. It sets a very high bar because it is an entry into the profession.”

In 2002, Nolan Watson, CA, was British Columbia's top UFE writer. Today, he is president and CEO of Sandstorm Resources Ltd., a publicly traded resource company.

As the former CFO of TSX- and NYSE-listed Silver Wheaton Corp., Mr. Watson was instrumental in raising more than \$1 billion (U.S.) in debt and equity to fund the company's growth.

“I prepared for the UFE with lots of practice and lots of study. There's no

magic to doing well. You just have to keep practising,” says Mr. Watson.

The skills and discipline required to succeed on the UFE are the same as those required to excel in life, he notes.

“If you are a CA, people know you understand the fundamentals of business. If you want to be successful in business, get a CA designation.”



GIACOMO ANGELINI, CA

The 2003 Ontario gold medallist Giacomo Angelini, CA, who is now a senior manager with Deloitte & Touche LLP in Ontario, says, “The UFE is a rigorous process. This is not the kind of exam you write and come out of thinking, ‘I got the Gold Medal.’ I spent a year preparing for it and I was just hoping to pass.”

Doing well on the exam earned him recognition within the industry as someone with a high level of technical expertise which, in turn, led to opportunities to pursue the work in which he wished to specialize.

“I like working on public companies and large private companies. Deloitte's Securities Group reviews all public documents for clients issuing securities and for significant transactions on the public markets. There is high risk associated with these transactions, and given the size of the companies, they are very complex. I wouldn't have been able to step into this role without my CA education and training.”

Finally, there is the unspoken commitment CAs have to give back to society. Mr. Angelini, for example, is active within his community and serves as the president of the Hamilton District CA Association. “We network among CAs and support our communities by raising money for local charities and doing tax returns for low-income people.” □

A desire to see the world is a key reason why Porsche Cars Canada Ltd.'s director of finance Roberto Fazio chose to become a CA.

“From an early age, I recognized two things: my talents lay in mathematics and I wanted to explore beyond the boundaries of my Edmonton hometown,” says Mr. Fazio.

After graduating from the University of Alberta in 1990, he quickly meshed his talent and his career goals by accepting an audit manager position at PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP in Hungary.

It was the start of a decade-long tour of central and eastern Europe where he was able to witness first-hand how state-owned factories were run before being introduced to Western accounting and business practices.

The rigorous education and examination process opens a lot of doors. It allowed me to teach at the University of Toronto, McMaster University and at the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Ontario's School of Accountancy, all of which I enjoyed.

As a graduating university student, you might not know where you want to be in 10 or 15 or 20 years – the CA designation gives you choices.”

Being a CA and carrying on with continuing education, such as the Controllershship Program, has helped me better manage business services and participate like a business owner. I'm constantly looking at different opportunities that exist for and within the organization.

In today's environment, the training and experience that you get while auditing and articling as a CA are invaluable and give you a tremendous amount of insight. Real life experience is second to none.”

“I joined PricewaterhouseCoopers as a summer student in 1999 and left in mid-2003. My family is very entrepreneurial, and I always planned on eventually moving in that direction, but circumstances meant I had to realize that dream earlier than expected.

My primary job now, beyond the usual financial role, is signing new licences for merchandising. Artimonde is Canada's largest distributor of licensed apparel. The biggest challenge is identifying artists or properties and meeting with their manager or the licence holder, whether it is the Rolling Stones or Marvel Comics.

I was only 24 when I started, but my designation and financial training gave me a huge boost of confidence. The key to success is being well prepared with marketing plans, and purchasing and distribution forecasts. Ethics and integrity are essential in this business, and the fact that I am a CA gives our company enhanced credibility because our profession's code of ethics is very strict.”

GOING GLOBAL

Times may be tough, but there is no shortage of opportunities for Canadian CAs eager to travel the globe in search of international experience.

Qualified CAs find that once they get business experience, their skills are highly portable and valued, and can be applied around the world.

Changes in accounting rules that now require companies to call on professionals familiar with International Financial Reporting Standards will only increase the mobility of Canadian Chartered Accountants.

Today's CAs are likely to find global firms more than willing to put their finance, accounting and leadership skills to work. For this reason, Canadian CAs are working throughout the world and in major financial centres such as London, New York and Tokyo.

Here are two Chartered Accountants who took their CA designations global.

SAJEDA BANA, CA

England



A CA since 2005, Sajeda Bana moved to England three years ago to take a job with PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP, where she is now a manager in the firm's financial services practice.

Her role is demanding. Among other things, she oversees teams of auditors who deal with some of the world's leading financial institutions.

“It seemed like an exciting place to be,” says Ms. Bana, who is on an extended secondment from PwC's Toronto office where she had been a senior associate with a focus on auditing mutual funds.

The Ontario native said she opted for a career as a Chartered Accountant because of the many opportunities it would provide. With offices around the world, an organization like PwC offers its staff the chance to travel and gain international experience in diverse and exciting locales.

“Working in London has turned out really well for me because it has given me the opportunity to both travel and make a good living,” she says.

Since moving there from Toronto in November 2006, she has formed a social circle that includes other former students from the University of Toronto. She often takes weekend trips to Barcelona and Paris and notes, “Even going to places like Africa is easier.”

You might say CA Mathieu Jacques' career is on a skyward trajectory.

For the past two years, the Quebec native has been working in Poland, as manager of Pratt & Whitney Canada (P&WC) Financial Shared Services with WSK PZL-Rzeszow.

A CA since 2001, Mr. Jacques applied for the role because he wanted to add to the international experience that he had previously gained working as an internal and external auditor with Quebecor World and Deloitte & Touche LLP respectively, while based in Montreal.

“I always dreamed of moving to another country and gaining the experience of working abroad,” he says.

As the Canadian contact person for the P&WC finance organization, he oversees a department of 70 Polish employees.

Working in a rapidly changing country like Poland, Mr. Jacques has found that his biggest challenges include dealing with cultural differences and building a strong team.

He says meeting these hurdles has helped him grow as a manager in surprising ways. “I'm better able to understand the needs of my customers and meet their expectations,” he says. □

I earned a Bachelor of Commerce degree at the University of Victoria. Going on to achieve a CA designation seemed like a practical way to build on and develop my commerce theory skills. I've always loved analytical thinking and problem-solving, two key aspects of the career of a Chartered Accountant.

I worked at KPMG LLP for several years but during the final lead-up to the UFE, I moved on to work at the City of Colwood, near Victoria, where I'm the Acting Deputy Director of Finance. I was fortunate that several of the people I worked with were CAs because they were a great help in prepping and encouraging me as I prepared for the UFE. If you don't have the resources of a firm, you're really reliant on yourself and any CAs who will share their experiences.

As for the future, I love where I am today; however, I've always been really passionate about teaching and helping others learn. Once I have more experience under my belt, I'd love to be involved in education, whether through CASB (CA School of Business) or a post-secondary institution.”

“I was enrolled in a master's program at Memorial University and working as a teaching assistant when an accounting instructor told me about the advantages of becoming a Chartered Accountant.
